

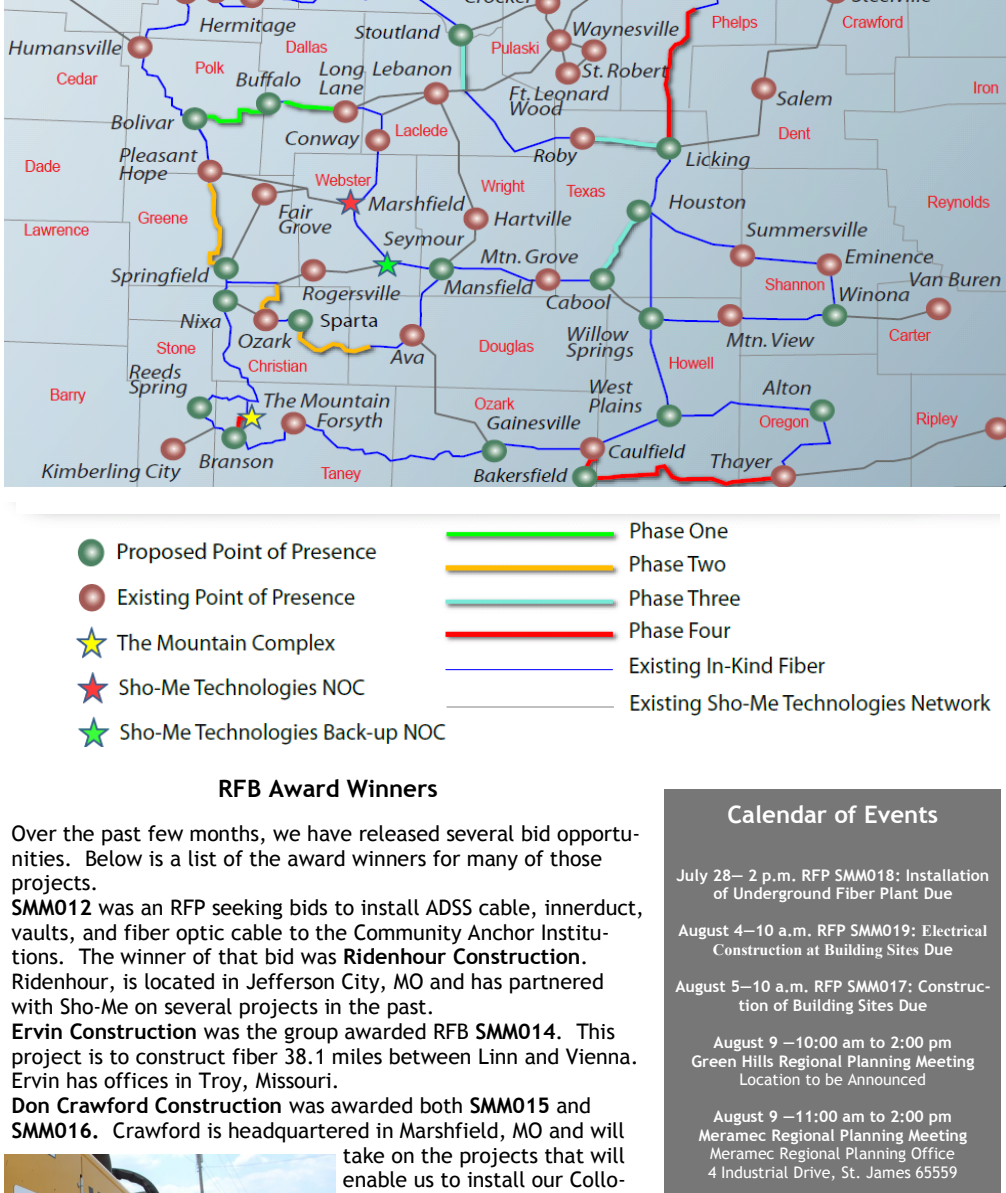
Project Update

The Sedalia to Warsaw route continues to expand with a total of 29.4 miles of innerduct installed. The route will total 54 miles once completed, so we are happy to hit the half way mark on this route. We also plan to have our first Community Anchor Institution turned up this week. We are working on the route between Jefferson City and Linn. We started this route in the community of Linn. With five crews working on this segment, we hope to have construction in the city complete later this week. Another leg of construction started this past week. Six crews are working on the Linn to Vienna route. More updates to come.

RFB Award Winners

Over the past few months, we have released several bid opportunities. Below is a list of the award winners for many of those projects.

SMM012 was an RFP seeking bids to install ADSS cable, innerduct, vaults, and fiber optic cable to the Community Anchor Institutions. The winner of that bid was **Ridenhour Construction**. Ridenhour, is located in Jefferson City, MO and has partnered with Sho-Me on several projects in the past.

Ervin Construction was the group awarded RFB **SMM014**. This project is to construct fiber 38.1 miles between Linn and Vienna. Ervin has offices in Troy, Missouri.

Don Crawford Construction was awarded both **SMM015** and **SMM016**. Crawford is headquartered in Marshfield, MO and will take on the projects that will enable us to install our Collocation buildings around our network.

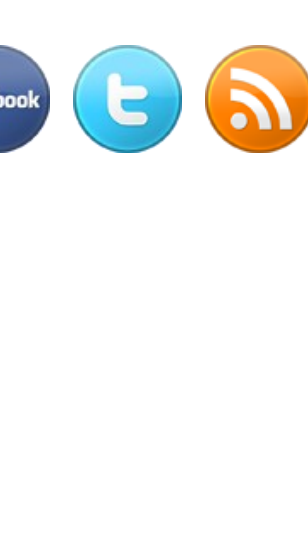
Telecommunication Hotels
